APICS Certified Supply Chain Professional (CSCP)

A new industry educational and certification program created to focus on the entire supply chain...supplier through operations to customers and beyond...and meet the ever-expanding needs of supply chain management.

Becoming an APICS CSCP candidate

The CSCP examination is available to individuals who have relevant work experience and education and would like to advance their careers by obtaining a broader understanding and increasing their knowledge on all areas that make up the supply chain.

Eligibility for the APICS CSCP Exam

Candidates must submit a request to qualify to take the exam. This request form is found on the APICS Web site - www.apics.org. To be eligible for the APICS CSCP, exam a candidate must meet one of the following criteria.

- Bachelor's degree or equivalent, plus two years of related business experience, or
- APICS CPIM, APICS CFPIM, APICS CIRM, or C.P.M. designation plus two years of related business experience, or
- Five years of related business experience.

Instructor-Led Classes in 2007

Two instructor-led classes will be held in Columbia, S.C., at Midlands Technical College, Northeast Campus. These classes will consist of five Saturdays spaced at least four weeks apart for the individuals to accomplish the required reading before each class. The classes are from 8 am - 5 pm each day with a 45-minute lunch break. The students will be responsible for lunch. The following are the dates of the classes.

- Feb. 10, March 10, April 7, May 12, and June 2
Exam is June 23.
- July 28, Aug. 18, Sept. 8, Oct. 13, and Nov. 3
Exam is December 8.



Classes will be held in partnership with Midlands Technical College located at the Northeast Campus.

The APICS CSCP Learning System contains the following four modules:

DAY 1.....

Supply Chain Management Fundamentals

- Develop a supply chain strategy that aligns with corporate strategy.
- Assess and measure the effectiveness of supply chains.
- Establish a continuous improvement process for supply chains.

DAY 2.....

Building Competitive Operations, Planning, and Logistics

- Establish collaborations to replace or improve demand estimates.
- Learn how to include supply chain factors in product design.
- Develop and implement plans for using 3PL and establish collaborations to replace or improve demand estimates.
- Learn how to include supply chain factors in product design.
- Develop and implement plans for using 3PL and 4PL service providers.
- Understand the increasing importance of reverse logistics.

DAY 3.....

Managing Customer and Supplier Relationships

- Understand customer loyalty and lifetime value of a customer.
- Establish measures of customer satisfaction.
- Understand the strategic importance of supplier and purchasing relationships.

Using Information Technology to Enable Supply Chain Management

- Understand the role of data and information technology in the supply chain.
